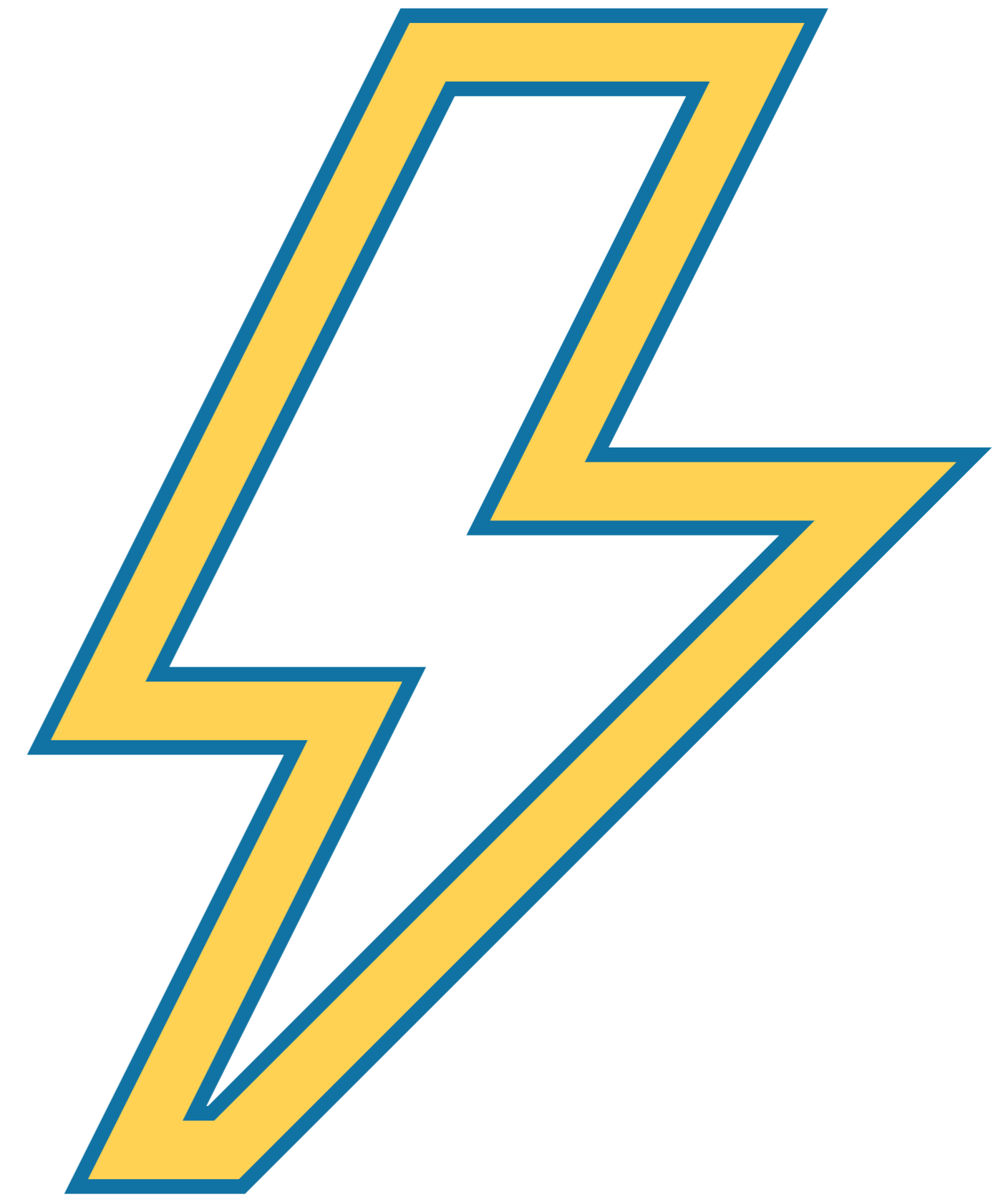
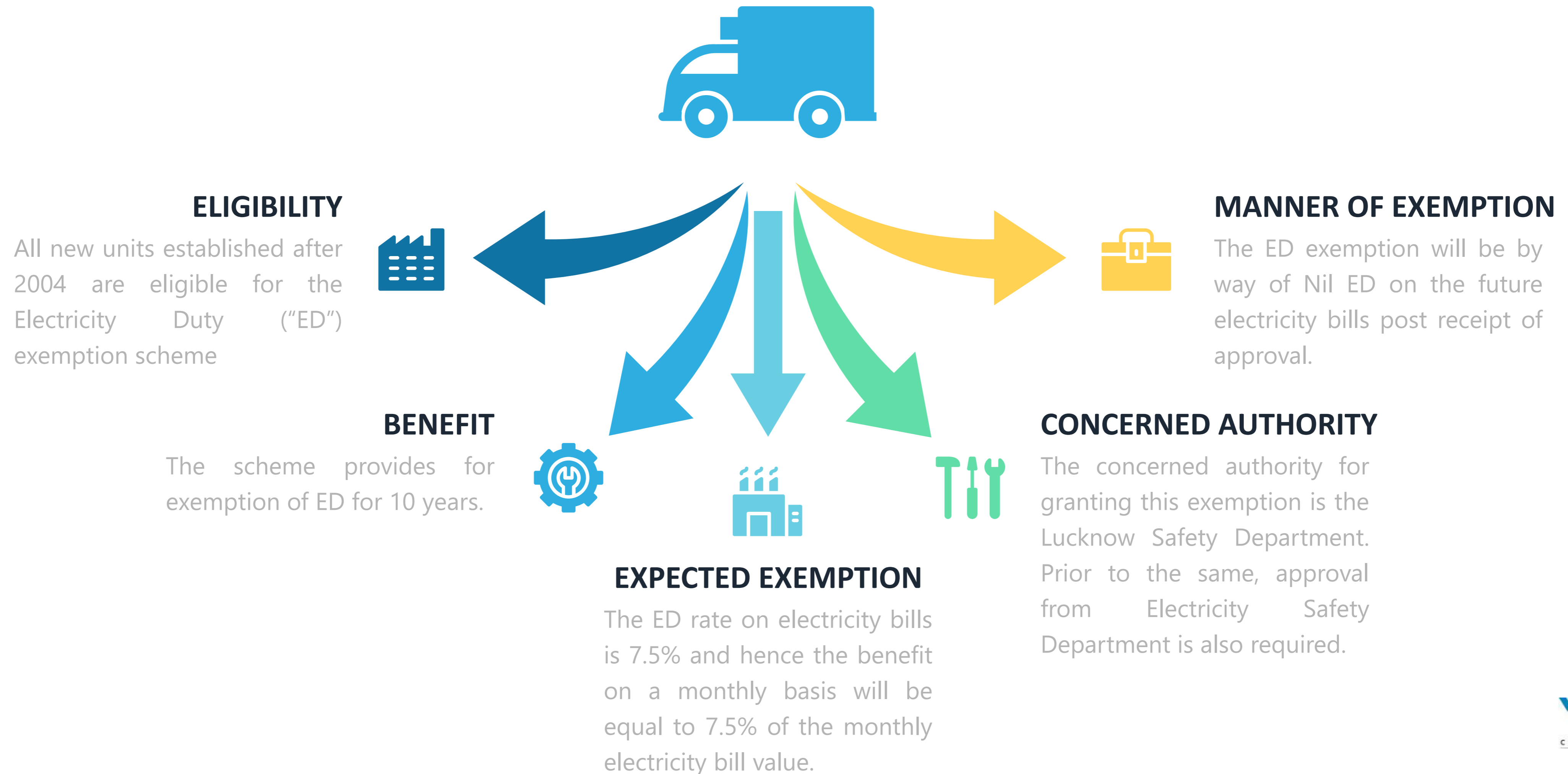

## ELECTRICITY DUTY EXEMPTION PROCESS FLOW

### ELECTRICITY DUTY EXEMPTION

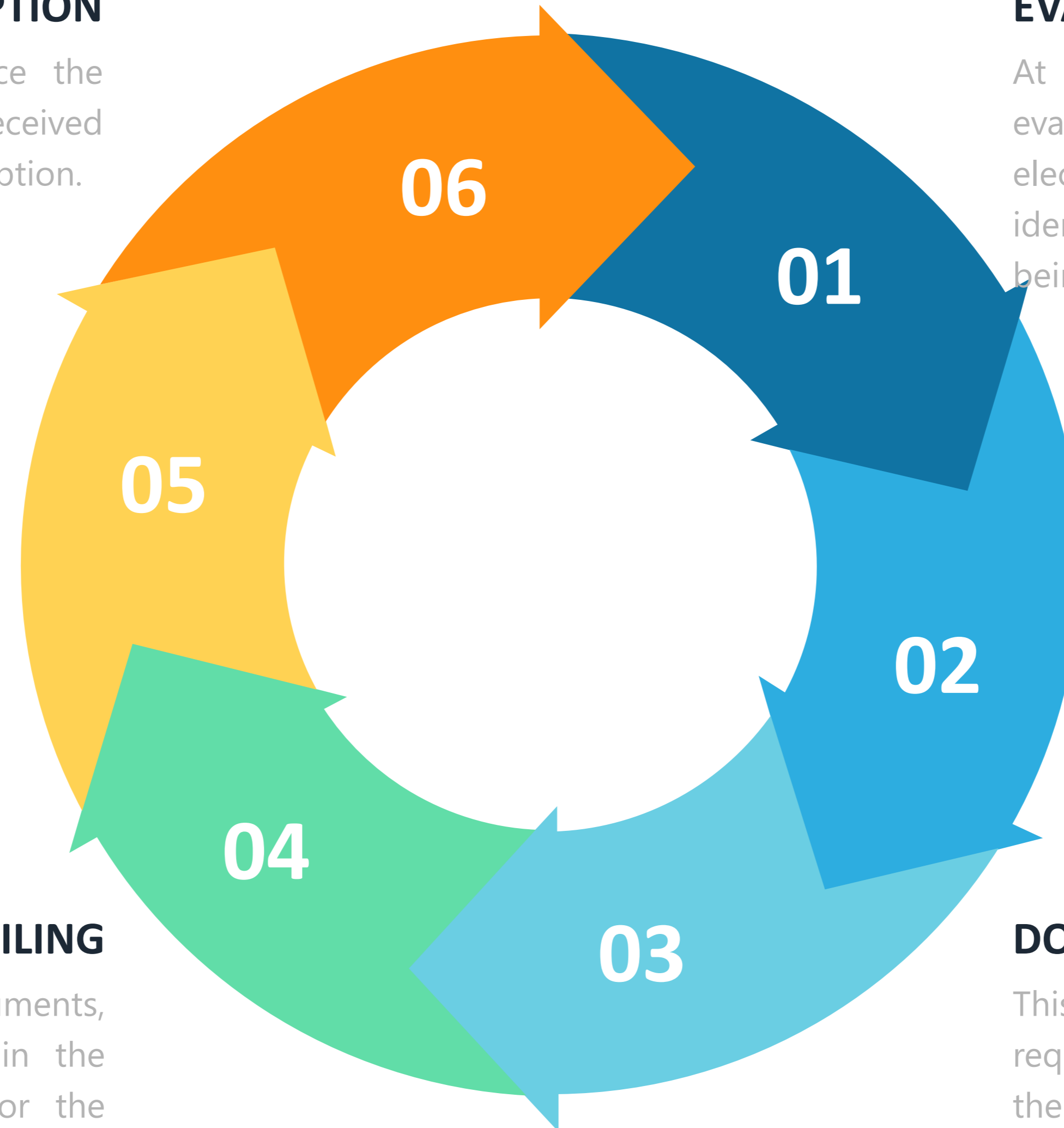
Process will be completed once the monthly electricity bills are received without any ED, i.e., with ED exemption.

### ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE

This stage involves obtaining the eligibility certificate under the Scheme for Electricity Duty Exemption

### APPLICATION FILING

On preparation of all the documents, the application shall be filed in the name of the industry and / or the landlord who owns the property



### EVALUATION

At the first stage it needs to be evaluated as to what is the average electricity bill for the past 12 months to identify the average Electricity Duty being charged

### OWNERSHIP OF THE PROPERTY

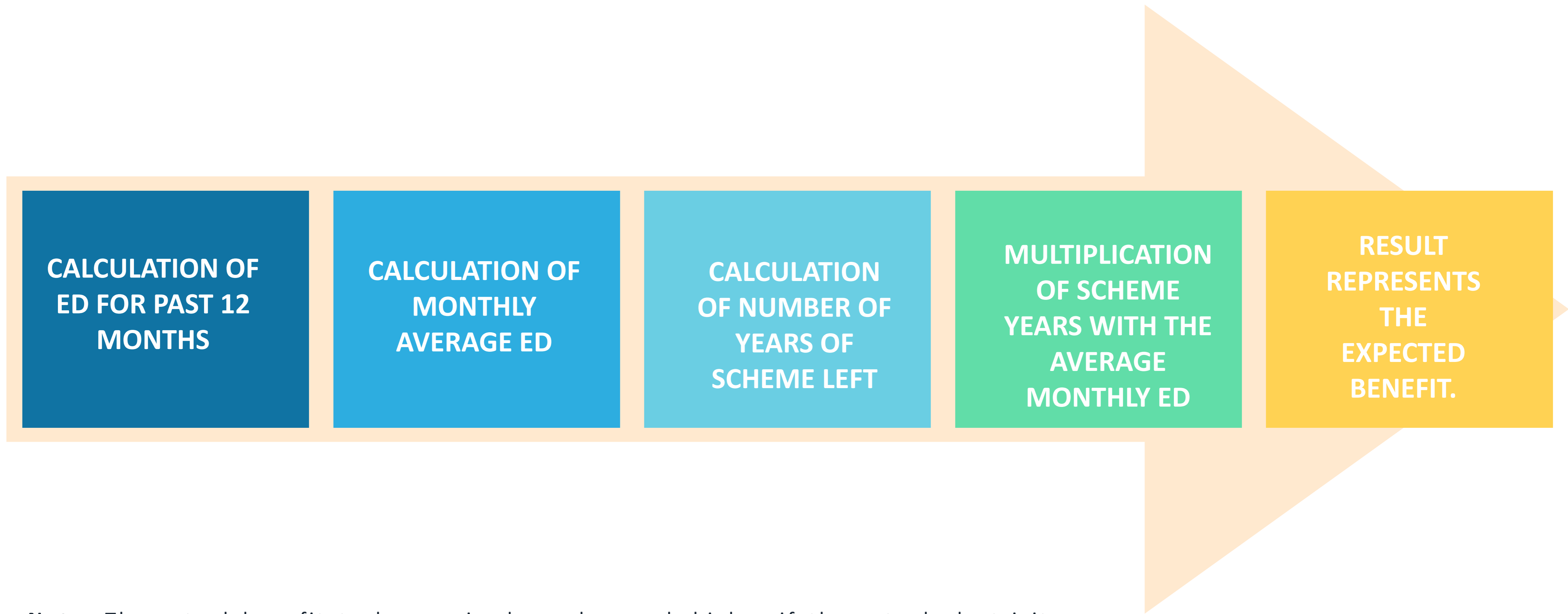
At this stage it needs to be evaluated as to who is the owner of the property in which the Industry is run, i.e., the Landlord or the Industry company itself.

### DOCUMENTATION

This step involves preparation of all the required exemption documents such as the Electrical Connection NoC, Meter Ceiling Certificate etc.

## BENEFIT CALCULATION



**Note:** The actual benefit to be received can be much higher if the actual electricity consumed in later months is high. The actual future benefit shall always be linked to the actual ED charges in the future.
